Re: 2024 CHS Start of Year Information

Please find below information for the beginning of the 2024 CHS School Year:

STAGGERED START: In 2024 we will have a staggered start with our Year 7, 12 and Disability Unit students returning on Monday 29th January. Our remaining students, including Special Options, will join us on Tuesday 30th January.

STAGGERED START - DAY 1 (YEAR 7 & 12): Our Year 7 students will meet on Monday at 8:50am in the Gym. Our Year 12 students will meet in the Wellbeing Centre.

DAY 2 WHOLE SCHOOL ASSEMBLY (YEAR 7-12): We will have our first Assembly from 8:50am for all students in the Gym. From here students will move into their Year Level groups and then Roll Classes. House Meetings will occur prior to Recess.

2024 CHS MEET THE TEACHER & PARENT EVENING: Please mark Monday 12th February (Week 3) on your calendar. In 2024 we will be offer one big evening for the whole school, with the opportunity for parents to meet Roll Class teachers, Learning Area Coordinators, Year Level Coordinators, Wellbeing Support, Learning Support, Senior Leaders and Governing Council all on this night. More details to follow in Week 1.

2024 CHS SWIMMING CARNIVAL: Our 2024 CHS Swimming Carnival will be held on Friday 2nd February (Week 1). This will be a day carnival.

STUDENT SERVICES: Will be open 18th-21st December for 2024 purchasing. Our Business Manager Heather Guthrie will then return to school from Friday 19th January for all Uniform purchases, School Fee payment, Maths Dictionary and calculator/safety glasses sales. In 2024 there will be a second smaller top up mini pack on Day 1, Term 3 to top up student supplies. These items are part of the Materials and Services Fee. These are itemised in attached lists. There is then a list of recommended stationery items for you to purchase for the relevant Subjects and Year Levels.

STATIONERY SUPPORT: In 2024 we are once again supporting students and families with stationery if required. These donated items will be available for families to come in and collect free of charge from Monday 22nd January or when your child returns to school in Week 1 from Mandy Knight in Wellbeing Centre. If you are able to donate any workbooks, A4 Display Folders with clear sleeves or stationery please drop these to Student Services.

2024 TIMETABLE & ROLL CLASS QUERIES: Kylie Alozie (Timetable) and I (Roll Classes) will be available at school to meet or via email and Daymap from Monday 22nd January in the week prior to school returning to support any individual student or parent queries.

2024 UNIFORM INFORMATION: Please see attached Uniform Update Information Letter with all key information around uniform and transition to new CHS uniform items.

2024 IT INFORMATION: For the 2024 school year there will be no sessions held with parents and no requirement for parents to book a session to have their child's laptop/device configured. Instead, parents should keep an eye out for an email with details about how to set it up at home. It is important, however, to make sure the device is activated and working. For students who are looking to purchase a new device for 2024, please take the time to consider the options available through the LWT Purchase Portal www.clarehs.orderportal.com.au Though you may still choose to purchase from any retailer, the devices available for purchase through LWT, cover a range of prices, and have all been reviewed and considered adequate for use at CHS. Please consider the significance of the included 3-year warranty and on-site support available with purchases through LWT when making a decision. For purchases through LWT, please refer to LWT portal for estimated shipping and delivery information. Please also consider if the device requires insurance or check with your home insurer if the device is covered at school. Unfortunately, accidents happen and can be expensive to repair.

When preparing for school consider the case you will keep your device in. Hard sided, well-padded cases offer better protection to your device than a slipcover style case. A sturdy case will keep your device safe when moving between lessons or traveling to and from school.

Please Note that since 2021, Apple Devices (including MacBook) are not acceptable as a BYOT device and will not be connected to the school network.

For new students: Turn on your device, set up the device with a local user account or students own Microsoft account. Parents do not use your Microsoft account to setup a students login profile. Once logged in make sure Windows is working properly, and get used to using your device. Allow plenty of time for faults to be rectified through warranty and await further Information about connecting to the school network, to be distributed by email to parents.

For current students: It is important to check your device through the school holidays. Turn it on to make sure that it is still working and also that any updates are installed (Windows). It is also important that current students log-in to EdPass during the holidays. An active EdPass password is essential in maintaining connection to Office 365, Microsoft OneDrive, Teams and ClickView, among other things, and will save a lot of time at the start of Term 1. Also, check for faults- if the device was purchased through LWT, send an email to the address listed below so that repairs can be organised asap and, if the device was purchased elsewhere, please allow enough time to repair faults before school starts. 2024 STUDENT TIMETABLES: Student Timetables will be available on Daymap from 15 January 2024. We will also be emailing the students school account with their timetable in Week 10, 2023.

Re: CHS Uniform Update Information Letter

In 2022 we undertook an extensive CHS Dress Code Review involving our whole school community (Parents, Students and Staff) to ensure the inclusion of our new CHS logo. At the end of Term 4 our Governing Council ratified our new CHS Dress Code Policy. During 2023 our new Uniform Items have gradually become available, most recently with the arrival of our CHS Polo with Ngadjuri artwork and some of our Formal Uniform items.

Thank you once again to our CHS Dress Code Review Working Group members for their work in this space; Governing Council Representatives: Trish Byerlee, Ingrid Smith, Student Representatives: Amber Douglass, Alex Head, Matt Vincent, Ella Smith, Ruby Naughton, Charlotte Smith, Parent Representatives: Cherie Pilkington, Staff Representatives: Katie Liebelt, Kiara Schulz, Andy Lee and Nat Sommerville.

At our most recent Governing Council Meeting we reviewed our CHS Uniform roll out and agreed on the following:

- Our new CHS Uniform items will become compulsory from Week 1, Term 1, 2025.
- Current 2023 Year 10-12 students will not be required to purchase the new CHS Uniform items (but may still choose to buy the new uniform items).
- We will continue to offer discounted current Uniform Items and bundle packs for purchase


