Student Selection Requirements

Step 1: You are to write an application of no more than one A4 page in which you address the following:

- Explain why you wish to participate in the trip to Cambodia
- Explain what personal qualities you have that make you a good representative of Clare High School, including the ability to live away from home for two weeks, and the ability to speak in public at assemblies or at meetings.
- Explain how you believe you will benefit from participating in this trip
- Give any examples of how you have contributed to Clare High School's international program by being a host family or school-based buddy.

Step 2: You are required to provide the contact details for two referees, either of whom may be contacted as a part of the selection process. They should be able to speak about your character and ability to cope as part of a group on an overseas trip. **Referees should not be family members**. They can be roll class or subject teachers, employers, coaches, family friends, etc.

Step 3: You may be required to attend an interview with a panel of staff and/or community members at which you will be asked to provide more evidence of the extent to which they meet the criteria.

Criteria for Selection

Students will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- 1. Mature, responsible student who will represent Clare High School well and with a record of good conduct. Students will not be permitted to participate if externally suspended in the period from the beginning of the school year until the commencement of the exchange.
- 2. Demonstrated interest in this trip.
- 3. Demonstrated commitment to Clare High School's international program (such as having been a host or school-based buddy for an international student). This is not essential but is an advantage.
- 4. Demonstrated ability to share your experiences with others, perhaps in a public speaking experience.
- 5. If everything else is equal, then preference may be given to students who are in Year 11 and 12 in the year of the exchange (younger students will have another opportunity to participate in the next trip).
- 6. Preference may be given to students who have not already participated in an international trip and who have modelled our school values at a high level throughout their schooling.
